RETIRING FROM THE EVENT

If you decide you do not wish to continue with the event. Then you must inform a marshal at a checkpoint or at the finish area. Please also remove your event number and pass it back to a marshal.

RACE FINISH

The race finishes at the same place as the race start above. Again please pass through the timing system scanners at the entrance to event field.

Medals will be given out when you finish.

If you purchased a t-shirt as part of your entry this will also be given out as you finish. From the mountain rescue team.

MANDATORY KIT

1. Appropriate footwear for the terrain (walking boots or fell running shoes)
2. Waterproof top and trousers
3. Spare fleece or similar garment
4. A functioning torch and whistle (six flashes or blasts in an emergency, repeated every minute).
5. A simple first aid kit
6. A map and compass (and know how to use them)
7. A survival (bivi) bag
8. Reserve food and water/drink

CHECK POINTS & REFRESHMENTS

The online maps show the checkpoints that you pass through and which ones have water.

CHANGE FROM LONG TO SHORT COURSE

At checkpoint 2 you will have the opportunity to change from the long course to the short course. You must inform a marshal at the checkpoint though.

FINALLY

Please be aware that the first mile of the route follows a quiet public road that is not closed to traffic. We will have marshals on the road and signs up to let drivers know . But, please be observant and follow the highway code.

We look forward to welcoming you to Alwinton on Saturday. We hope you enjoy the challenge and the route.
